
Spiritual Multiplication

- I. Biblical basis for spiritual multiplication.
 - 1. God's command to "make disciples" passes down to every believer—Matthew 28:18-20—is in the imperative mood—"make disciples"—command. "Teach disciples all I commanded you"—He just commanded us to make disciples.
